




The closing date is drawing near, so if you have not already done so, [enter your team now](#) for the **SALTERS' FESTIVALS OF CHEMISTRY** which are being hosted at Universities and Colleges across the UK and Ireland between March and June 2016.

One team of **four** students per school are welcome to participate from:

- Year 7 and/or 8 in England and Wales
- Year P7 and/or S1 in Scotland
- Year 8 and/or 9 in Northern Ireland
- Primary 6 and/or Secondary Year 1 in the Republic of Ireland

Students will experience 2 hands-on practical Chemistry challenges, exciting chemical

demonstrations, a Prizegiving ceremony with prizes for winning schools and fun prizes and certificates for all participants.

All this costs ONLY **£25 (€30) per school** (non-refundable) plus travel expenses.

We are delighted to announce **Brunel University London** as a new venue hosting Festivals in 2016! Two Festivals will be held at the University which is based on the outskirts of Uxbridge, London on **Tuesday 15 March** (priority will be given to schools with students with special educational needs - see below) and **Thursday 17 March**.
