



Salters' Institute **GRADUATE AWARDS**

Graduate Awards of £1,000

Every year The Salters' Institute offers up to ten awards, each of £1,000, to final-year undergraduates studying at UK universities. Candidates are expected to obtain a First Class Honours Degree in either Chemistry or Chemical Engineering in the Summer of 2019.

Awards are based on an assessment of the potential of candidates ultimately to occupy leading positions in public life, either by employment in the Chemical or related industries, or more generally in employment that supports the industrial life of the UK. Candidates are expected to show some knowledge of the Chemical industry's current situation and the need for changing technology in the future. In reflecting these aims, the selectors look particularly for: -

- Intellectual ability
- Capacity to initiate
- Ability to communicate his/her interest and enthusiasm to a wider audience
- Ability to enlist the co-operation of others, whether colleagues or subordinates
- A concern for the future of the UK industrial base
- A willingness and ability to take part in the Institute's activities

The Head of each University Chemistry or Chemical Engineering Department may nominate one candidate. Each nomination should be accompanied by a confidential reference, which pays special attention to the aims listed above. Awards will be made to successful candidates following the completion of their Honours degrees and they, along with their Head of Department, will be invited to an Awards Ceremony in December 2019.

The **closing date** for nominations is **Monday 18 February 2019**.

Interviews for shortlisted candidates will take place on **Wednesday 27 March 2019** at Salters' Hall.
